Damian Basso will also be supporting the program this year as our Senior Liaison, working closely with Peter to ensure our junior age groups (U12–U16) are aligned with the senior program. This will help strengthen our pathway and better support junior players transitioning into senior football in the future.

2026 Play Football Registration

Parents must register their child on Play Football prior to January 31st. Play Football Registration is now open for all junior players.

When registering your child, FSA requires you to pay an additional fee of \$113 which provides insurance coverage for your child in the event of injury throughout the season.

Invoices have been sent by our club registrar. **Players will not be approved for the season unless their fees are paid in full.** If you have any enquiries regarding payment of fees, please email futdfc@yahoo.com.

Communication

Your child's Team Manager is the first point of contact for any issues or questions that may arise throughout the season. If needed, the Team Manager will pass your message on to the appropriate club officials.

During the pre-season period, either your child's coach or Team Manager will contact you to advise which communication platform the team will be using (e.g. Heja, WhatsApp).

It is extremely important that you join your team's communication group, as this will be the primary way you receive important information about training, games, and club events, and it will allow you to contact your Team Manager when required.

- Fundraising & Events (supporting planning and coordination of fundraising activities and club events)
- Government Grants (assisting with identifying and applying for relevant grants)

Team Managers

Every team requires a Team Manager to support the coach with communication and to liaise with the Junior Committee regarding important information and notices. An induction will be held for all team managers prior to the season commencing, and support will be provided throughout the year. If you are willing to assist in this role, please let your child's coach know.

At times, team managers may ask parents or family members to assist with game day roles, including:

- Referee (MiniRoos are not assigned referees by FSA. U12–U17 usually have referees, but this is not guaranteed.)
- Linesperson
- Ground Steward

While these roles may seem daunting, they are straightforward, and any help, big or small, is greatly appreciated to ensure the kids can play and enjoy their game.

FSA Parents and Junior Players Code of Conduct

All players, parents, carers, and spectators involved in Football SA-sanctioned activities are expected to uphold the highest standards of behaviour.

The FSA Parents and Junior Players Code of Conduct is designed to ensure football is a safe, respectful, and enjoyable environment for everyone. It outlines expectations that all participants will:

- Treat players, coaches, referees, volunteers, and spectators with respect
- Support children positively, focusing on effort, enjoyment, and development
- Accept referee decisions and display good sportsmanship
- Avoid abusive, aggressive, or inappropriate language or behaviour
- Promote fairness, inclusion, and the spirit of the game

By registering your child, families acknowledge and agree to abide by the Football SA Code of Conduct.

Breaches of the Code may result in action from the club or Football SA.
